Fourteen gifts to those who fast

Fourteen gifts to those who fast

At this stage I cannot find a better gift or greater masterpiece than to present to those who fast gifts from the Prophet of goodness sallallahu 'alaihi wa 'alaihi. They are those practical hadiths that have been mentioned in connection with rewards and blessings. He told them that the hadiths that lead to the doors of happiness and the paths of goodness in this world and the Hereafter O you who fast! Record these hadiths and implement them:

1. The Prophet sallallahu 'alaihi wa 'alaihi said: "Whoever says at dusk: 'There is no God save Allah alone, He has no partner, so His belongs the dominion and the praise and He has power over all things'... ten good deeds will be written for him, ten misdeeds will be erased, and he will be elevated ten levels. He will be protected from Satan until evening, and if he says it in the evening, he would have the same rewards until morning." (Ahmad, Abu Dawud, Ibn Majah, al-Hakim).
2. The Prophet sallallahu 'alaihi wa 'alaihi also said: "Whoever says in the morning or in the evening: 'O Allah! You are my Lord, there is no God beside You, you created me and I am Your slave and I have taken a covenant to You and promised You what I am able to do, I seek refuge with You from the evil of what I have done, I acknowledge Your favor upon me and I acknowledge my sins, forgive me because none forgives sins except You. If a servant died during the day or night after having said this prayer, he will enter Paradise.'" (Ahmad, Abu Dawud, Al-Nasa'i, Ibn Majah, Ibn Hibban, Al-Hakim, al-Hakim, Al-Bukhari transmits another version of this hadith).
3. Again the Prophet sallallahu 'alaihi wa 'alaihi said: "Whoever says at morning or evening: 'Glory and praise be Allah the Great' one hundred times, no evil will come forward on the Day of Judgement with better than he; except if someone said the same as him and added to it: (Muslim, Ahmad, Abu Dawud, Al-Tirmidhi).

Militants storm NATO bases

21 fighters dead • Dozens of girls poisoned at school

KABUL: US and Afghan troops repelled attackers wearing American uniforms and suicide vests in a pair of simultaneous assaults before dawn yesterday on NATO bases near the Pakistani border, including one where seven CIA employees died in a suicide attack last year. The raids appear part of an insurgent strategy to step up attacks in widely scattered parts of the country as the US focuses its resources on the battle around the Taliban's southern birthplace of Kandahar.

Also yesterday, nearly 50 female pupils and teachers were rushed to the hospital after an apparent toxic gas attack at a Kabul high school, the government said. It was the second case of poisoning at a girls' school in the capital this week. Officials suspect the Taliban, who oppose female education. The militant assault in the border province of Kunar began about 4 am when dozens of insurgents stormed Forward Operating Base Salerno and nearby Camp Chapman with mortars, rocket-propelled grenades and automatic weapons, according to NATO and Afghan police.

Two attackers managed to breach the wire protecting Salerno but were killed before they could advance far into the base, NATO said. Twenty-one attackers were killed: 15 at Salerno and six at Chapman and five were captured, it said. Three more insurgents, including a commander, were killed in an airstrike as they fled the area, NATO said. The Afghan Defense Ministry said two Afghan soldiers were killed and three wounded in the fighting. Four US troops were wounded, NATO officials said.

US and Afghan officials in Islamabad said the attack on the Haqqani network, a Pakistan-based faction of the Taliban with close ties to Al-Qaeda. Camp Chapman was the scene of the Dec 30 suicide attack that killed the seven CIA employees. Afghan police said about 50 insurgents took part in the twin attacks.

50 percent rise in male pipe cancer

LONDON: The rate of MALE food pipe cancer in men in the UK spiked by 50% over the last 25 years, figures reveal yesterday. Cancer Research UK said the annual number of men diagnosed with oesophageal (food pipe) cancer rose from 2,644 in 1983 to 3,964 in the last year for which data was available. The charity said poor diet and higher levels of obesity could be behind the increase.

Food pipe cancer is the ninth most common cancer in the UK. In 2007, around 8,000 people were diagnosed with the disease. It is seen in one of the trickier cancers to detect and treat, with only 9% of sufferers living for more than five years. In 1983 rates of food pipe cancer in men stood at 9.6 in every 100,000. This has now jumped by 50% to 14.4 per 100,000 men. The most dramatic rise was seen in men in their 50s. Over the last quarter century, rates increased by 67% for the age and sex group. Rates in women also rose, but by a slower rate, figures show.

Professor Janusz Jakowicki, cancer specialist at Barns and the London School of Medicine and Dentistry, said: "We don't know exactly why we're seeing this steep rise in oesophageal cancer rates, and why it's having such a dramatic effect on men. But we think the obesity epidemic may be a big reason behind the increase. We know that being overweight significantly increases the risk of adenocarcinoma - the main type of oesophageal cancer that is on the up. "Our changing diets are also likely to be influencing the rise with people eating less fruit and vegetables." — KINA

Mideast talks: Fast clock, big hurdles

WASHINGTON: US-sponsored talks between Israel and the Palestinians began Wednesday with a goal to fast-track a peace deal inside one year, an ambitious schedule even under the best of circumstances, those involved here said.

For starters, the Palestinians have threatened to walk out past four weeks after talks begin. A 10-month slowdown in West Bank housing construction by Israel is set to expire at the end of September, and the government is divided over whether to extend it. The Palestinians have warned they will pull out of the new round of negotiations if building resumes. The West Bank was warned to make up the bulk of an independent Palestinian state alongside Israel, with precise borders to be drawn at the peace table. Expansion of Jewish housing makes those borders even more complicated.

The militia in Hamas movement, opposed not only to talks but to Israel's very existence, is in firm control of the Gaza Strip. Gaza, which is also supposed to be part of a negotiated Palestinian state, has been the staging point for rocket attacks on Israel that have led to an almost complete Israeli blockade of the territory.

Neither Israel Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu nor Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas has much political elbow room at home.

The failure of past peace efforts has left both sides with rigid demands and public ambivalence about the value of a negotiated settlement. To this day's horizon, President Barack Obama brings the promise of impartial leverage and a steady hand at each man's back. Despite his popularity abroad, many Palestinians and Israelis are skeptical of Obama, and suspect the US has a finger on the scale. Face-to-face talks between Netanyahu and Abbas will be the first for the two sides in nearly two years, since talks broke down under Netanyahu's predecessor at the close of.

Saudi throws out dissident lawsuit

RIYADH: A Saudi judge yesterday threw out a dissident's lawsuit over his three-and-a-half-year detention without trial, saying the government had finally filed its charges against the democracy activist. Riyadh governance court judge Abdul Aziz Al-Mutairi rejected calls to free Salim Al-Reshoudi in the first ever test of the government's eight-year-old law requiring that detainees be released after six months if proceedings have not begun.

Mutairi said he received an official message late on Friday that Rashed had been informed of the charges behind his 2007 arrest with several other activists. He said Rashed and the others were advised of the charges in Jeddah on August 15, putting those cases in motion and rendering moot Rashed's year-old lawsuit against the security police and interior ministry for detaining him without charge.

Supporters of Rashed, 73, angrily denounced the judge's decision as a stunt, saying the Jeddah assignment was conducted in secret inside a prison, with no lawyers or witnesses, and questioning whether there was even a judge present. The charges have not been revealed, but are believed to relate to allegations that the men gave support to Islamic extremists, activists said. "This court is typical, a part of the oppressive political system," said Abdullatif Al-Hamed, a member of the Saudi Civil and Political Rights Association (ACPRA) which organized Rashed's case. Saudi Arabia is an absolute monarchy and prohibits all political.

Iraq war 'ending'

Obama marks end of US combat

VINEYARD HAVEN: Three days before the official end of the US combat mission in Iraq, US President Barack Obama said yesterday that the war in the country was "ending" and called Iraq a "sovereign" nation free to determine its own destiny. "On Thursday, after more than seven years, the United States of America will end its combat mission in Iraq and take an important step forward in responsibly ending the Iraq war," Obama said in his weekly radio address. The president, who speaks his last full vacation day at on the island of Martha's Vineyard, Massachusetts, will cover the issue of Iraq in a nationally televised address from the Oval Office on Tuesday.

Encephalitis kills 215

NEW DELHI: At least 215 people, mostly children, have died in an outbreak of Japanese encephalitis in an impoverished region of northern India and the death toll is likely to soar, officials said yesterday. Eastern parts of India's most populous state Uttar Pradesh are ravaged by encephalitis each year as malnourished children succumb to the virus which is transmitted by mosquitoes from pigs to humans but this is one of the worst outbreaks, officials said.

The deaths of four more children yesterday pushed the toll to 215, with hundreds sick, some two to a bed, in hospitals in Gorakhpur, a deeply neglected area of 14 million people, regional health officer UK Srivastava said by telephone from Gorakhpur. "A total of 1,204 patients had been admitted in hospitals until yesterday in Gorakhpur," which is the epicenter of the outbreak, and "more encephalitis patients are coming into our hospitals," Srivastava said. The outbreak began in early July.
